## RESOLUTION NO. 2016-122

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH MARICOPA COUNTY IMPLEMENTING A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT TO WAIVE TRAFFIC CONTROL PERMIT FEES IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria (City) Mayor and City Council are authorized by Title 9, Chapter 2, Article 4, Section 9-276 (1) to lay out and establish or otherwise improve streets, alleys, avenues, sidewalks, etc. and by Title 11, Chapter 7, Section 11-951 *et seq.* to enter into Intergovernmental Agreements with other governing bodies for services or joint exercise of powers; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County implementing a cooperative agreement to waive traffic control permit fees in certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, by the City approving the Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County the public interest will best be served.

THEREFORE, it is resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria, Maricopa County, Arizona, to approve and adopt this Resolution to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County implementing a cooperative agreement to waive traffic control permit fees in certain circumstances.
