RESOLUTION NO. 2022-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MARICOPA COUNTY AND THE CITY OF PEORIA TO IMPLEMENT A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT TO WAIVE TRAFFIC CONTROL REVIEW AND PERMIT FEES IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria Mayor and City Council are authorized by Title 9, Chapter 2, Article 4, Section 9-276 (1) to lay out and establish or otherwise improve streets, alleys, avenues, sidewalks, etc. and by Title 11, Chapter 7, Section 11-951 *et seq.* to enter into intergovernmental agreements with other governing bodies for services or joint exercise of powers; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County (County) to implement a cooperative agreement to waive traffic control plan review and permit fees in certain circumstances;

WHEREAS, by the City entering into the Intergovernmental Agreement with the County the public interest will best be served.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria, Maricopa County, Arizona to approve entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the County to implement a cooperative agreement to waive traffic control plan review and permit fees in certain circumstances.
