

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY BOARD – Residency Requirement w/ Exceptions

Authority: City Code, Chapter 3, Sections 3-1, 3-6 and 3-21

Members: 7 + 1 Alternate [residency exceptions] + Economic Development Services Director as non-voting member

- Four members who shall be employed in any of the following occupations:
 - Public or private higher education, consisting of an accredited college or university;
 - Licensed or registered professions of this state in the fields of architecture, engineering, commercial and office or industrial development;
 - Federally or state chartered lending institutions;
 - Business advocacy organizations;
 - Public or private utility companies;
 - Commercial or industrial real estate development;
 - Business development or corporate site selection companies.
- Three regular and one alternate members who are residents of the City.

Duties: The Board shall make recommendations to the Council on economic development issues including the Economic Development Element of the City's General Plan, economic development related projects, strategies for promoting economic development in the City, representing the community with prospective economic development prospects, and cooperate with educational institutions and regional economic development organizations.

Duties: The Commission is responsible for the identification and recommendation to Council for the designation of landmarks, increase public awareness of historic, cultural and architectural preservation, approve/disapprove applications for Certificate of Appropriateness and establish a uniform schedule of fees for services.
