

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-86

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF GLENDALE AND THE CITY OF PEORIA FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES FOR SIGNING, PAVEMENT MARKINGS, AND OTHER TRAFFIC CONTROL PLACED ALONG BOUNDARY ROADWAYS.

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria Mayor and City Council are authorized by A.R.S. Section 9-276.A.1 to lay out and establish or otherwise improve streets, alleys, avenues, sidewalks, etc. and by A.R.S.11-951 *et seq.* to enter into intergovernmental agreements with other governing bodies for services or joint exercise of powers; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Glendale for the installation and maintenance responsibilities for signing, pavement markings, and other traffic control placed along boundary roadways between Glendale and Peoria;

WHEREAS, by the City entering into the Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Glendale, the public interest will best be served.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria, Maricopa County, Arizona to approve entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Glendale for the installation and maintenance responsibilities for signing, pavement markings, and other traffic control placed along boundary roadways between Glendale and Peoria.
