

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-123

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PEORIA AND THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE REGARDING THE UNIFORM ADMINISTRATION, LICENSING, COLLECTION, AND AUDITING OF TRANSACTION PRIVILEGE TAX, USE TAX, SEVERANCE TAX, JET FUEL EXCISE AND USE TAX AND RENTAL OCCUPANCY TAXES IMPOSED

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Peoria are empowered pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 11-952 et seq. and Peoria City Charter Article 1, Section 3(15) to enter into intergovernmental agreements and contracts for services and/or the joint exercise of powers common to the contracting parties for the purpose of joint or cooperative action incident thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria desires to enter into an intergovernmental agreement proposed by the Arizona Department of Revenue regarding the uniform administration, licensing, collection, and auditing of transaction privilege tax, use tax, severance tax, jet fuel excise and use tax and rental occupancy taxes imposed by the State or cities or towns; and

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria has examined and approved the form and content of the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement and is now determined to enter into the agreement for the purposes stated therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Peoria as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Council of the City of Peoria hereby approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement, attached hereto and expressly made a part hereof as Exhibit 1 including appendices A, B and C to Exhibit 1, with the State of Arizona Department of Revenue, on behalf of the City of Peoria
