

## 2024 Board and Commission Possible Code Changes (as of 05/13/2024)

- Subcommittee mentioned adding two alternate members to each board
  - Add global language to *Sec. 3-6. Boards and Commissions; terms.*
  - Removed alternate member language from specific Boards and Commissions.
  - Language adds flexibility for alternate members for all Boards and Commissions.
- Remove “Community Facilities” from Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Board and remove library interest from Parks and Recreation Board and add it to the Arts Commission
- Change the name of the Arts Commission to the Arts & Culture Commission (culture would encompass the library interest), unless we have to say “Arts, Culture, and Library Commission”.
- Remove “Memorial” from Veterans Memorial Board and require all members to be residents of Peoria.
- *Section 5-3. Municipal Court; appointment of assistant municipal judges, judges pro-tempore, court administrator, civil hearing officer, and other court employees* reads “Judicial Selection Advisory Board”. This board and the Public Defender Contract Review Board merged in 2019 creating the Judicial and Public Defender Advisory Board
- *Section 3-46. Youth Advisory Board; establishment and membership.* This addresses, students who live in a “County Island” area but attend a school inside the City limits of Peoria.
- Not included in current changes/under review by City Attorney’s Office: Council Youth Liaisons were previously outlined and provided for in the Code; however, during a significant 2017 Code update, language was removed and not readdressed in the Chapter 3. CAO is reviewing whether this needs to be addressed in Code or is sufficiently addressed in Council Policy: Youth Advisory Board Council Liaison Program.
- Minor spelling, grammatical and consistency updates.
