

AMENDMENT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT
AGREEMENT

THIS CONTRACT AMENDMENT is made on this this 13th day of May 2025, between the City of Peoria ("City"), and Emily Jurmu, ("City Attorney").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City have entered into a Terms and Conditions of Employment Agreement with the City Attorney dated April 2, 2024, (hereinafter "Agreement") for provision of those duties and functions of the City Attorney, as provided under the Peoria City Charter and Code and in accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 9-271: and

WHEREAS, the City and City Attorney desire to amend the Agreement.

Therefore, the parties in consideration of the covenants and conditions to be performed by the City Attorney set forth in the Agreement dated April 2, 2024, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement, effective April 1, 2024, as follows:

Section 4. Amendment to Section 4

Section 4 ("Salary") shall be amended to read as follows:

Effective April 26, 2025, City agrees to pay Employee for her services rendered pursuant hereto as City Attorney an annual Base Salary of two hundred sixty-six thousand seven hundred and sixty-eight dollars (\$266,768) payable in installments at the same time as other employees of the City are paid.

Section 5. Amendment to Section 5

Section 5 ("Deferred Compensation") shall be amended to read as follows:

Employer agrees to pay the City Attorney deferred compensation an amount equal to Seven Percent (7%) of Base Salary per year, to be paid to the City's mandatory 401 (a) plan for the City Attorney in even installments each pay period, or as a lump sum payout as wages with the election for the year to be made no later than June 1, 2025 and a one-time only, lump sum payment equal to Five Percent (5%) of Base Salary, to be paid to the City's 401(a) plan for the City Attorney on the June 13, 2025.

Employer agrees to pay twenty thousand, seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$20,750), into the City's Section 457 Deferred Compensation Plan in even installments each pay period. The City Attorney may elect to contribute additional amounts to the Section 457 Deferred Compensation Plan, pursuant to provisions of such plan and in conformance with the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended.

City and City Attorney agree that except solely as modified above, changed and amended, the terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement and subsequent amendments thereto, shall continue in full force and effect and shall apply to, and shall govern this Amendment of the Agreement.

IN WITNESS HEREOF, the City of Peoria has caused this Agreement to be signed and executed in its behalf by its Mayor and duly attested by its City Clerk, and the Employee has signed and executed this Agreement, both in duplicate, the day and year first written above.
