

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-99

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE UNITED ARIZONA VETERANS APPLICATION FOR GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, United Arizona Veterans, a local nonprofit agency, dedicated to providing tuition assistance, scholarships, and financial contributions that support community services led by honorably discharged veterans and their family members; and

WHEREAS, United Arizona Veterans requested a State-Shared Revenue Grant from Gila River Indian Community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria is authorized to enter into this Grant with the Gila River Indian Community pursuant to A.R.S. 11-952 which provision empowers Arizona political subdivisions to enter into intergovernmental agreement with Federal entities and agencies, such as Indian Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the Gila River Indian Community administer a State-Shared Revenue Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the public's best interest would be served by the City supporting the United Arizona Veterans application, which will assist in supporting their scholarship and financial aid program;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria, Maricopa County, Arizona as follows:

SECTION 1. Approved support of the United Arizona Veterans Grant proposal for Gila River Indian Community State-Shared Revenue Grant funds of \$30,000.

SECTION 2. Agrees to perform the duties of the fiscal agent and comply with all appropriate procedures and guidelines established by the Gila River Indian Community as part of this process.
