Dear Mr. Faust:

This letter is to inform you that your agency's project(s) has been selected for funding through the Federal Fiscal Year 2025 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities grant program for the Phoenix-Mesa-Scottsdale Urban Area. The Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG) Elderly and Persons with Disabilities Transportation (EPDT) Committee developed a priority listing of projects according to criteria outlined in the grant application and the available FTA funding apportionments for the region. Final projects were approved by the MAG Regional Council and forwarded to the City of Phoenix Public Transit Department, the designated recipient of FTA funding and grant administrator. Your agency has been awarded the following grant assistance:

Capital award amounts listed for vehicle(s) are based on the estimated cost of procurement and will be adjusted when final vehicle costs are identified. If the final cost exceeds the total awarded funds, **subrecipients may be responsible for additional matching funds to cover the remainder cost of the vehicle(s)**. Eligible FY 2025 Section 5310 project expenses may be incurred beginning October 1, 2025. However, the FTA can only process reimbursements upon *both* the execution of a grant pass-through agreement with the City of Phoenix, and the final grant award. The City of Phoenix Public Transit Department will notify sub recipients when the FTA grant has been awarded, and expense reimbursements can be processed.

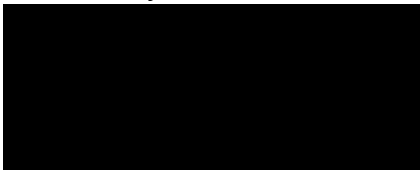
As the City of Phoenix administers the grant program procurement, part of the award process will require your designated agency's representative to attend a grant orientation meeting. The City of Phoenix will forward an invitation with the time, date,

and location of the orientation. This orientation will provide attendees with information regarding grant pass-through agreements, reimbursements, reporting and record keeping, vehicle deliveries and procurement, and compliance requirements.
