

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-104

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE THEATERWORKS APPLICATION FOR TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, TheaterWorks, a nonprofit performing arts organization in Peoria, is seeking \$15,000 to support its youth education programs; and

WHEREAS, TheaterWorks is requesting a State-Shared Revenue Grant from Tohono O'odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Peoria is authorized to enter into this Grant with the Tohono O'odham Nation pursuant to A.R.S. 11-952 which provision empowers Arizona political subdivisions to enter into intergovernmental agreement with Federal entities and agencies, such as Indian Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation administer a State-Shared Revenue Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the public's best interest would be served by the City supporting the TheaterWorks application, which will assist in providing transformative arts experiences to youth throughout the West Valley;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria, Maricopa County, Arizona as follows:

SECTION 1. Approved support of the TheaterWorks grant proposal for Tohono O'odham Nation State-Shared Revenue Grant funds of \$15,000.

SECTION 2. Agrees to perform the duties of the fiscal agent and comply with all appropriate procedures and guidelines established by the Tohono O'odham Nation as part of this process.
