

FIRST AMENDMENT of the INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
between
THE CITY OF PEORIA
And
THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS
on behalf of the UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA and its College of
Agriculture, Life Sciences & Environmental Sciences' Arizona Project
WET Program

This First Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement (Agreement), by and between the City of Peoria, located at 8401 West Monroe Street, Peoria, Arizona 85345, authorized to contract under its Charter, and the Arizona Board of Regents, on behalf of University of Arizona's College of Agriculture, Life & Environmental Sciences Extension, Water Resources Research Center, Arizona Project Wet Program (hereafter "APW") and authorized to contract under A.R.S. § Section 15-1625, is entered into pursuant to A.R.S. § Section 11-952.

In witness whereof, the parties hereto agree to carry out the following amendment of the November 1, 2015 Agreement. Pursuant to Section 11 the Agreement terminated on October 31, 2025. The parties desire to continue the Agreement and hereby agree to extend the Agreement through April 30, 2026, effective from the date the Agreement expired.

Pursuant to the terms of amendment defined by Section 14 of the Agreement, the parties agree to minor changes that will refine the original Agreement's scope of work, the deliverables, and the cost of the extended Agreement, as follows:

Section 3, **Work Program and Deliverables**, is updated in this Amendment and replaces the original language in Section 3 of the IGA.

Work Program and Deliverables:

A. During the extended Agreement (ending April 30, 2026), Arizona Project WET will:

2026 Fiscal Year - 7/1/25 – 4/30/26 (extended from 10/31/25)

During the 2025/2026 academic year, Arizona Project WET will conduct two Water Festivals, one in Fall and one in Spring which entails:

1. Conducting teacher professional development workshops, as needed, to support the Arizona Water Festival Water Unit.
2. Surveying teachers' knowledge gain as a result of the teacher workshop.
3. Working with school district specialists to schedule schools, classrooms, teachers, and students for the Water Festival event.
4. Continuing to award professional development credits to qualifying personnel for the teacher workshop in accordance with district's guidelines.
5. Maintaining equipment and supplies for use at the Peoria Water Festival event.
6. Training volunteers to facilitate water festival rotation lessons ahead of the Peoria Water Festival.
