

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 5 TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MARICOPA COUNTY, ADMINISTERED BY ITS HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT, AND THE CITY OF PEORIA FOR THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE MARICOPA HOME CONSORTIUM AND APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HOME CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the HOME Investment Partnerships Program (“HOME Program”), authorized under Title II of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act (42 U.S.C. § 12701 et seq.), provides federal funds to expand the supply of decent, safe, affordable housing for low-income households;

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) permits units of general local government to form consortia for the purpose of qualifying as a Participating Jurisdiction under the HOME Program, pursuant to 24 CFR Part 92;

WHEREAS, the MARICOPA HOME CONSORTIUM has been recognized by HUD as a HOME Consortium and has entered into a three-year Consortium Agreement approved by HUD;

WHEREAS, the CITY OF GOODYEAR desires to join the Consortium and participate in the HOME Program through the Consortium, and has negotiated an amendment to the Consortium Agreement to add [Name of Jurisdiction] as a member;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria, Maricopa County, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Council hereby approves participation in the MARICOPA HOME CONSORTIUM and authorizes execution of the Amendment to the Consortium Agreement adding CITY OF GOODYEAR as a member.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or designee, upon the recommendation of the Neighborhood & Human Services Department and City Attorney’s Office is authorized to execute the Amendment to the Consortium Agreement and any related documents necessary to effectuate participation in the Consortium, subject to HUD approval.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

SECTION 4. The Mayor, City Clerk, and City Attorney are authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to give effect to this Resolution.
